# FACEBOOK...Myspace

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- Anything that may show who you are on the internet needs to be privatized by June 20th.
- Especially FACEBOOK!!!!
- Take off all pictures that have alcohol in them---you are not 21, this should not be a problem---NO RED CUPS!!!!
- If a PNM asks you to be her friend---LEAVE IT PENDING!
  - We are getting a facebook application for PNM's only so you can refer them to this group.
- YOU SHOULD NOT BE TALKING TO ANY PNM DURING THE SUMMER.

# Welcome Week

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- There are rules during this week that we all need to follow.
  - During Welcome Week you are to not go to a unofficial SPOP reunions, fraternity parties, etc. Basically anywhere where PNM's could be there.
  - You are to not go anywhere in more than groups of 4.
    - When you are walking on campus with your fellow sisters, there should only be you and three others at one time.

# Welcome Week

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- ❑ We are getting Greek T-Shirts---you are to wear them on Monday at the Anteater BBQ.
- ❑ Tuesday and Wednesday, you can wear anything you want.
- ❑ Day 1----Thursday and Friday
- ❑ Day 2---Saturday
- ❑ Pref. Night--Sunday
- ❑ Bid Day---Monday, at the ARC fields.

# Silence Period

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- Silence period begins the day of Pref. Night. It ends at 3:00pm on Bid Day, when PNM's receive their bids.
- What is it?
  - It is NO contact AT ALL with any PNM. If you have a class with them, do NOT initiate a conversation or sit next to them. NO conversations on Ring Road and definitely do NOT have lunch with them.
  - DON'T BE AWKWARD, they are still human beings. If they say hello then say hello back, but clarify to them that you are not allowed to be talking to them at this time.

# BID Day

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- The day and night of BID Day is supposed to be a day you spend with your new members.
- Take them to dinner, dessert, to a movie, etc.
- Do NOT go to parties and do NOT consume alcohol on this night. You are allowed to talk to boys starting Tuesday at 9:00am.

# What is Positive Panhellenic Contact????

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- Positive Panhellenic Contact is promoting the ENTIRE Panhellenic Community, NOT your specific affiliation.
- For example,
  - If I said, “as a Greek Community we all have philanthropies, and we all have social functions, no matter which sorority you choose you will love it, and have a great time.”

# Question...

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- During Welcome Week a PNM walks up to you and asks you a question about your Chapter, what do you say?

## Answer...

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- Tell them they should check out the Panhellenic Booth and refer any questions to Recruitment Counselors or Panhellenic Exec.

# Question...

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- On Ring Road during Welcome Week there of course is a lot of commotion. Fraternities have booths out to publicize who they are and, of course, to get your attention. If one of your fraternity guy friends comes up to you and gives you a BIG FAT HUG, what do you do?

# Answer...

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- PUT YOUR HANDS STRAIGHT AT YOUR SIDE AND RUN.....
  - Just kidding....don't be awkward. Give him a hug back, but DON'T linger. Give him seconds, they know you are not supposed to be there and they know they are not supposed to be talking to you. They know that having a 5 minute conversation will get you an infraction. So MOVE ON and you can hang out with them in a week.
